ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME THIS DEPUTY RESPONDED TO SHORT STAY, NAVAL RECREATIONAL CENTER, VILLE#30 IN REFERENCE TO A POSSIBLE RAPE. UPON ARRIVAL THIS DEPUTY AND RESERVE DEPUTY THOMAS, MET WITH SHORT STAY SECURITY, C. DANGERFIELD, AND ADVISED HIM OF THE SITUATION. BOTH UNITS THEN PROCEEDED TO VILLE #30 WHERE WE FOUND TWO BLACK FEMALES SITTING IN FRONT OF THE TWO STORY RENTAL UNIT. UPON APPROACHING THE TWO WOMEN I NOTICED A BLACK IN COLOR MERCEDES BENZ WITH THREE BLACK MALES IN IT. I IMMEDIATELY ASKED THE VICTIMS IF THE MEN IN THE MERCEDES WERE INVOLVED AND THEY REPLIED NO THAT THEY HAD JUST STOPPED TO LET THE GIRLS USE THERE CELL PHONE TO CALL FOR HELP. WHILE I ASSESSED THE GIRLS INJURIES THE MERCEDES PULLED AWAY LEAVING SHORT STAY. I IMMEDIATELY RECOGNIZED THAT THE TWO GIRLS VERY INTOXICATED IN SOME TYPE OF MANNER UNKNOWN TO ME AT THAT TIME. THE FIRST FEMALE TO SPEAK WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS MALIKA JOYNER, STATED THAT SHE HAD NO IDEA WHERE THEY WERE OR HOW THEY GOT THERE. I THEN TRIED TALKING TO THE SECOND FEMALE, LATER IDENTIFIED AS JESSICA NICOLE REID, WHO WAS CRYING UNCONTROLLABLY STATING THAT SHE JUST NEEDED HELP AND WANTED TO GO HOME. I THEN ADVISED

DISPATCH TO SEND ME A AMBULANCE TO CHECK THE GIRLS FOR INJURIES. I THEN PROCEEDED TO QUESTION THE GIRLS WHO WERE BOTH HAVING TROUBLE SITTING STILL AND KEEPING THEMSELVES UPRIGHT THOUGH THEY WERE SITTING UPRIGHT. JOYNER WAS ABLE TO ADVISE THAT SOMEONE UNKNOWN TO THEM PICKED THEM UP FROM THERE RESIDENCE IN SUMMERVILLE AND GAVE THEM A LIQUID TO DRINK THAT JOYNER STATED TASTED LIKE SODA. JOYNER STATES THAT IS THE LAST THING SHE REMEMBERED UNTIL SHE WOKE UP WITH A MAN TRYING TO KISS HER. JOYNER THEN STATES THAT SHE FORCED THE MAN AWAY AND WENT TO FIND HER FRIEND, REID. JOYNER STATED THAT SHE FOUND REID, IN THE ROOM ACROSS FROM WHERE SHE WAS, NAKED AND CRYING STATING THAT SHE HAD BEEN RAPED. JOYNER THEN STATED THAT SHE CALLED HER MOM WHO CALLED 911 TO SUMMONS THE

NARRATIVE

SHERIFFS DEPARTMENT FOR ASSISTANCE. THE AMBULANCE ARRIVED AND TREATED THE GIRLS AND TRANSPORTED THE TWO TO SUMMERVILLE MEDICAL CENTER FOR FURTHER TREATMENT. MYSELF AND CPL DAWSON WHO HAD ARRIVED ON SCENE PROCEEDED TO THE RENTAL UNIT TO MAKE SURE THAT THE SUSPECTS WERE NOT STILL PRESENT. SECURITY UNLOCKED THE UNIT AND MYSELF AND CPL DAWSON CLEARED THE RESIDENCE FINDING NO SUSPECTS TO BE PRESENT. DURING THE SAFETY SEARCH OF THE RESIDENCE I NOTICED THAT THERE WAS A STRONG ODOR OF WHAT I IDENTIFIED AS BURNT MARIJUANA, THAT I RECOGNIZED FROM MY EXPERIENCE AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER. SEVERAL EMPTY CONTAINERS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WERE ALSO LAYING AROUND GIVING THE IMPRESSION THAT A PARTY MAY HAVE TAKEN PLACE AT THAT RESIDENCE. I ALSO NOTICED THAT IN THE UPSTAIRS BEDROOMS, ONE BED WAS IN COMPLETE DISARRAY, WITH THE SHEETS COMPLETELY MESSED UP AND IN A PILE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE BED. A SILVER BRACELET WAS LAYING NEXT TO THE BED IN PLAIN VIEW WHICH WAS LATER SAID TO BE REIDS. A HOLE WAS NOTED IN THE WALL WHICH WAS SAID TO BE CAUSED BY REID. THE OTHER BEDROOM WAS IN ORDER HOWEVER THE SHEETS ON THE BED WERE PULLED BACK AS IF SOMEONE WAS READY TO GO TO SLEEP. MYSELF AND CPL DAWSON THEN PROCEEDED BACK OUT TO SIDE AND HAD DISPATCH NOTIFY THE DUTY DETECTIVE WHO ALSO NOTIFIED NAVAL AUTHORITIES WHO BOTH RESPONDED TO THE CRIME SCENE. THE CRIME SCENE WAS SECURED UNTIL THERE ARRIVAL AND TURNED OVER TO DETECTIVE CLINE WHO TOOK OVER THE INVESTIGATION. I STAYED ON SCENE SECURING THE CRIME SCENE UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 0630AM WHEN SGT PIPKEN RELIEVED ME AND I WENT OFF DUTY. ALL RELEVANT INFORMATION TO THE CASE WAS SHARED WITH DETECTIVE KLINE AND THE NAVAL INVESTIGATOR. THE SECURITY OFFICER, C. DANGERFIELD, STATED THAT HE DID SEE A BLACK IN COLOR LINCOLN TOWN CAR PARKED IN FRONT OF THE RENTAL UNIT EARLIER IN THE EVENING BEFORE THE CALL FOR HELP. ALSO PARKED IN FRONT OF THE UNIT WAS THE BLACK MERCEDES BENZ AND A SMALL GREY OR SILVER UNKNOWN TYPE VEHICLE. SECURITY OFFICER, C. DANGERFIELD STATED THAT ACCORDING TO HIS RECORDS A DERRIK MAJOR WITH AN UNKNOWN BRANCH RESERVE MILITARY IDENTIFICATION HAD RENTED THE UNIT BUT WAS NO WHERE TO BE FOUND.
